HOMELESS means lacking fixed, regular and adequate housing, which includes living in shelters, motels, cars, or temporarily living with other people because he or she had nowhere else to go.
UNACCOMPANIED means someone who is not living in the physical custody of his/her parent or guardian.
YOUTH means someone who is 21 years of age or younger, OR still in high school as of the day the FAFSA is signed.
