PROCEDURES:

A student who passes an Advanced Education examination shall be awarded course credit in a course with subject matter similar to that of the Advanced Placement examination. Credit shall be applied to General Education requirements of the General Education, Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum Education, Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC), or CSU General Education option.

Students who present scores of 3 (three) or better (depending on the subject matter) on the Advanced Placement Examinations may earn up to 6 (six) units of college credit and meet applicable General Education Area Requirements. Discipline faculty may set higher scores for acceptance of specific examinations.

These procedures shall be listed in the Solano Community College Catalog and posted on the Solano Community College website.
