Brief History of the Project

- Built in 1971 (45+ years old)
- Structural and Health & Safety Issues Identified in 2004
- 2008 Board resolution applying for state funding for reconstruction
- December, 2013 Updated Final Project Proposal
- November, 2016 State Facilities Bond passed
- Summer, 2017 Receive funding notice from the State

Preliminary Project Schedule

- FY 17-18 Architect/Engineer firm selection and Project Design,
 Site Due Diligence, Agency Approvals
- FY 18-19 Construction Documents Created with Detailed Design
- FY 19-20 Summer/Fall Bid and Award for Construction, Construction begins by Mid-Fall
- FY 19-21 Construction from Fall, 2019 thru May 2021
- FY 21-22 Occupy in Summer, 2021, Demo old Library and Close Out
