3. Agenda Approval	Academic Senate Vice President Scott motioned to approve the agenda of January 14, 2021 as presented. It was seconded by Senator Wesley. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Approval of Minutes	Senator Purdie motioned to approve the minutes of December 7, 2020 as presented. It was seconded by Senator Hidy. The motion was approved unanimously.

6. AS President Update

6.1 Hiring Manual Task Force Update

AS President Jaimez informed the Senate that the Hiring Manual Task Force had convened three times. The group is committed to diversity, equity, and inclusion and is reviewing the manual with this lens and the goal of diversifying faculty at Solano Community College. She will schedule a meeting with VP Williams and Human Resources for input.

6.2 New APR Chair Announcement

AS President announced that Senator Rachel Purdie will serve as the new Academic Program Review Chair.

6.8 Inherently Inaccessible Content Task Force

AS President Jaimez met with the task force and separately with Candace Roe and Dean Kristin Conner several times and review and create procedures to guide the following: (a) identification of inherently inaccessible content in online and face-to-face classes and provide resources to address identified issues, (b) reviewed/update policies and procedures for accommodation, and (c) addressed how inherently inaccessible content/courses will be managed (i.e. course substitution, course waiver). Once finalized, Dean Conner or/and Candace Roe will

<p>6.9 Nominations for Hayward Award Update</p>	<p>Michael Wyly (full time faculty) and Tony Zitko (part-time faculty) have submitted applications for Hayward Award. The selection process will be completed in February 2021 and winners will be announced during ASCCC Board of Governors meeting in March 2021.</p>
<p>6.10 Plan for afternoon joint meeting</p>	<p>AS President Jaimez expressed her appreciation to Alex Castaneda for her assistance in planning the Senate’s joint meeting with Administrators, SESC, Minority Coalition, and SCC students. A student survey was released and in five days twenty-one students replied. Two outcomes will be discussed during the afternoon. The results will be shared with SCC students for review to obtain their input on which items they would like to focus on during Spring 2021. Additional meetings will be scheduled with SCC students to review proposed actions and outcomes.</p>
<p>7. Superintendent- President Report</p>	<p>S/P Celia Esposito-Noy provided the following updates: (a) a four-minute video will be presented during Convocation, which will highlight good news that has happened over the last ten months, (b) she expressed her appreciation to Alex Castaneda for her efforts and participation as one of the presenters in the video, (c) January 2021 State budget is an indicator of what might occur; however, but the focus will be on the May 2021 revised budget, (d) per California Governor there is a significant increase in revenue; however this could potentially change next year, (e) SCC is mindful of expenditures and has a goal of reducing them by 3% every year for the next three years (when hold-harmless status ends), (f) there were about 3300 students who have not enrolled in Spring 2021, which were contacted by a group created Dean Lewis, (g) Dr. Regina Stanback- Stroud will continue to serve as an advisor of President’s Council for Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion during Spring 2021, and (h) she expressed her appreciation to Senator Beam and Dagmar Kuta for sharing SCC backdrop that faculty could access via Canvas.</p>
<p>8. VP of Academic Affairs Report</p>	<p>VP David Williams announced that enrollment rates are down. He encouraged faculty to consider accepting more students in class in anticipation of potential drops. He also stated that Senate will be creating a task force to assist in the creation of procedures for credit for prior learning. He invited faculty to join a trivia contest he will be hosting during Flex Cal on Friday January 15, 2021. He indicated that summer schedule will be online. He is hopeful that by Fall 2021, SCC will safely and gradually transition into some in-person classes. Lastly, he informed Senators he has had conversations with IT and Admissions and Records and waitlist should remain visible on class finder. He announced that add codes will be available on Friday, January 15, 2021</p>

and students will be able to use them on first day of the class they are enrolling in. He also referred faculty to an email he sent out earlier this week regarding recommended messaging in this situation.

The Senators discussed possible issues of adding this committee as it would need to follow Brown Act. As a result, on possibility is to have the chair/committee included in ByLaws as needed. This will allow the committee to assemble as an ad hoc committee for flexibility reasons.
