

Section 1:

When the Senate chooses to or is required to conduct an election, notification to the faculty shall be done within two weeks of the Senate's decision to hold the election, or within a reasonable time.

Section 2:

If the election requires faculty candidates to be nominated, submit nominations and/or submit their reasons for running, those faculty shall be given a minimum of one week, Monday through Friday, to respond, or a reasonably longer period of time.

Section 3:

Faculty shall receive at least Ten (10) School Days (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are School Days), to vote in Senate elections. The Academic Senate may choose to adopt and use any reasonable method when conducting an election involving the entire Faculty, including but not limited to: Paper Ballots, Postal Ballots, Email Ballots, or by Electronic/Digital methods of voting. The Senate may change the method or methods used for any Senate election, by a two-thirds majority vote of all the Senate members.
