Facilities Master Plan:

Gensler Associates will be surveying students (morning and afternoons) at all three campuses for their input into our planning.

All Gender bathrooms: these are now district standard.

Additionally, the campus is moving towards electronic key fobs for all doors, with remote lockdown capabilities.

SOAR: Damany Fisher has resumed working with SOAR (Students Overcoming Adversity & Recidivism). His temporary replacement, Chor Thao, will be working on new project: our title 9 compliance.
