#### S/P ESPOSITO-NOY REPORT

Administration is continually watching county and campus COVID data and criteria for resuming more face to face options in Week 6 of the semester. Senators inquired on the criteria. CalOSHA and County Public Health numbers were referenced.

Covid cases on campus were up 600% in the first 8 days of the semester compared to fall semester numbers. The goal is to minimize exposure to students and employees. Hopefully the west coast will soon follow the trend of declining numbers on the east coast.

Addition of 2<sup>nd</sup> dean to Hiring Committees: Administration would like to add a second dean to hiring committees to serve as a HR Equity officer (non -voting member) in order to provide coverage for HR matters, to train deans in the hiring process, and to allow broader participation in the committee work. Discussion ensued; S/P Esposito-Noy will gather more information and revisit this topic with Senate Exec.
