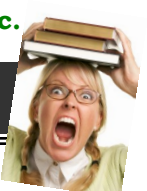
It's not too early to think about graduation!!

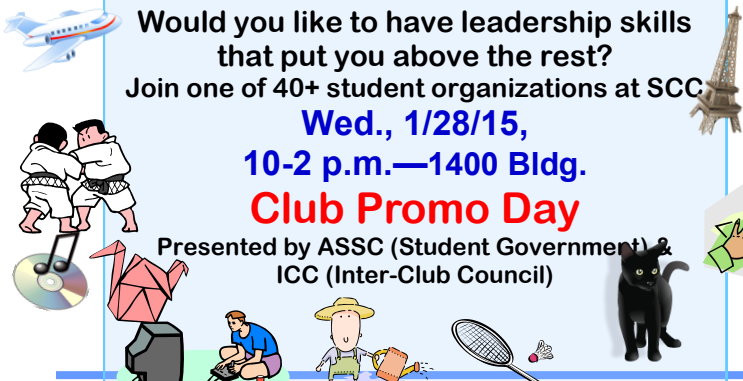

Student ID Cards

- Student ID cards are **still only \$5.00** and can be purchased online at *MySolano*. They are good for various merchant discounts, discounts at Solano College sporting events, and ASSC events. ID cards can be used to sell books back to the College Book Store, use the library and computer labs. They are required in the MAC Lab and the new Quiet Zone Study Lounge in room 1428 in the Student Union Building, 1400.
- Student ID cards are **valid for 9 consecutive semesters** (including summer) or 3 academic years. They must be validated each semester at no cost. Come to Room 1425 for a new sticker for the current semester.
- **Bring your printed Schedule Bill (from MySolano)**, showing \$5 Student ID fee has been paid, **and a state-issued photo ID** to the ID Card Station in Room 1425 (Student Development Office)

Handicap Parking at SCC

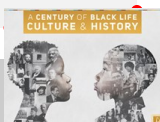


A **current parking permit along with a handicap placard or plates** are both required to park in handicap parking on all Solano College campuses.

The **person who owns the placard/plates must be present in the car when you park**. If you cannot show proof of ownership, the placard may be confiscated **and** a fine imposed.

Tuberculin (TB) Skin Testing is offered by appointment, **Mondays & Tuesdays 10:00 a.m. to noon, Monday & Tuesday, 4:00-5:00 p.m.** You must return in 48-72 hours post test to have the Tuberculin skin test read and receive your record of testing.

Health Screening exams are available at the Student Health Center for Children’s Program students. Drop-in or make an appointment for your Health Screening.

Screenings/testing: Health, diabetic, vision, hearing and urine screenings, are free to students.

Medications: Free over-the-counter medications for common conditions are available free to students at the Student Health Center. Medications include: generic choices of decongestants, pain medications, cough suppressants, decongestants, lubricating eye drops, burn gel, & more.

FREE Condoms: Includes X-large, latex-free & female condoms

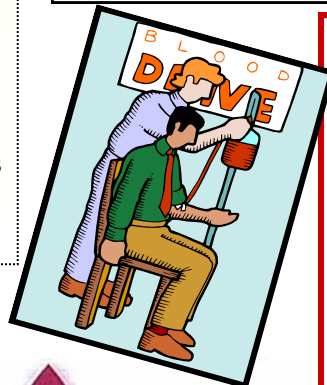


