In order to receive a Degree and/or Certificate from Solano Community College you must file a completed "Petition for Degree or Certificate" with the Office of Admissions and Records during the appropriate time frame. It is recommended that you meet with your counselor each term that you are in attendance at SCC to ensure that you are meeting the necessary requirements. In your last semester of attendance, you should submit your completed "Petition for Degree or Certificate" to the Admissions and Records Office. 

Monday & Tuesday, 4:00-5:00 p.m. You must return in
48-72 hours post test to have the Tuberculin skin test read and receive your record of testing.

Health Screening exams are available at the Student Health Center for Children's Program students. Drop-in or make an appointment for your Health Screening.




Handicap Parking at SCC

A <u>current parking permit</u> along with a handicap placard or plates are both required to park in handicap parking on all Solano College campuses.

Both placard/plates *and* parking **permit** must be clearly displayed.

The person who owns the placard/plates must be present in the car when you park. If you cannot show proof of ownership, the placard may be confiscated *and* a fine imposed.
