Notice to Students Regarding Parking on All Solano College Campuses

Fall semester classes begin on August 14th, 2017.

If you haven't already done so, now is the time to purchase your semester parking permit online through MySolano.

To purchase your parking permit:

- 1. Log into your student account on MySolano
- 2. Click on "Student Parking", located on the bottom right-hand side underneath the "Parking" header

Be sure to have a printer available at the time you make your purchase in order to print the temporary permit you'll need to use until your decal arrives in the mail. Purchasing a decal now for \$20 will eliminate your need to worry about having a permit for the entire semester.

Another option is to use the daily parking permit dispensers located on the perimeter of each of the campus parking lots.

Parking permits are refundable if you drop your class/es and the parking permit is returned to the Campus Sheriff's Office (Building 1800B, across from the tennis courts on the Fairfield campus) no later than the refund deadline of

your class/es. Be sure to check your Student Schedule/Bill to find the refund deadline of your class/es.

Parking enforcement will begin on Monday, August 21st.

<u>Final Step:</u> Have SCC Photo ID Card created on the spot! ID cards are valid for 3 years (9 consecutive semesters). **You Must Be**<u>Currently Enrolled to purchase an ID</u>

Crime Beat Tips

- When leaving your vehicle, be sure it is locked and secured. Lock any valuable items in the glove compartment or in the trunk. Do not leave anything of value out in the open for all to see.
- Be careful when driving in the parking lots. The speed limit in the parking lots is 10 mph. Campus Sheriff's Office deputies are enforcing traffic laws on all campuses.
- ✓Know your way around campus. In addition to paying attention to your surroundings; you should *know* your surroundings as well. Take time to become familiar with campus landmarks and building numbers so that you are able to navigate your way around or out of an area, should you need to. It will also be very helpful to direct Campus Sheriff's Office to your exact location in the event you needed their assistance.
- Please always be prepared for the unexpected. Visit our website at www.solano.edu/police/safetyaware.php and view the, "Run.Hide.Fight Surviving an Active Shooter Event Video" to better help you prepare for these types of situations.
- Also ensure records and admissions have your latest contact information so we can send you timely alerts and notifications should an incident occurs on our campus.
- Keep your cell phone with you at all times and ensure it is charged just in case you need to use it to call for help.
- ✓If you are working or studying late, arrange to leave with a friend or call Campus Sheriff's Office at 707-580-6526 (Fairfield Campus), 707-580-4936 (Vallejo Center) or 707-580-6054 (Vacaville Center) for Safety Escort assistance.

The 5-minute typing test is given in Rm 502, on Fridays 11:00am-3:30pm on the following dates:

There is no cost for the test, you just need to bring some form of identification with a picture.

Typing Certificate will show your words per minute/how many errors/ and signed by a proctor.
