You can take a typing test and receive a certificate immediately at the Solano Community College Main **Campus in Fairfield!** 

The 5-minute typing test is given in Rm 502, on Fridays 11:00am-3:30pm on the following dates:



September 8, 15, 22, & 29 October 6, 13, 20, & 27 November 3 & 17 December 1, & 8

There is no cost for the test, you just need to bring some form of identification with a picture.

Typing Certificate will show your words per minute/how many errors/ and signed by a proctor.


