

Early Assessment Program (EAP)

The Early Assessment Program (EAP) is a collaborative effort among the State Board of Education (SBE), the California Department of Education (CDE) and the California State University (CSU). The program was established to provide opportunities for students to measure their readiness for college-level English and mathematics in their junior year of high school, and to facilitate opportunities for them to improve their skills during their senior year.

Test Determinations

English

- Ready for CSU or participating CCC college-level English courses
- Ready for CSU or participating CCC college-level English courses Conditional
- Not yet demonstrating readiness for CSU or participating CCC college-level English courses

Mathematics

- Ready for CSU or participating CCC college-level mathematics courses
- Ready for CSU or participating CCC college-level mathematics courses Conditional
- Not yet demonstrating readiness for CSU or participating CCC college-level mathematics courses

Exemptions

Students whose results indicate **Readiness** are **exempted** from taking English and/or Math placement test at SCC.

Student whose results indicate readiness are eligible to enroll into following English and/or Math courses at SCC:

- English Reading 062
- English Writing 001
- Math 11, 12 and 30

Accepting EAP Scores at SCC

Students may request their EAP test scores to be cleared at SCC by submitting request to Assessment Center

Requests must include the following information

- Full name
- Date of birth
- High school
- Year student attended 11th grade
