For the Sentence Skills assessment test, you can attempt this test twice in three years. If you are unsatisfied with your testing results, there is a one week waiting period before you can re-test. Once a student has completed a Solano writing course and it shows on your record, the student **may not** re-test in sentence skills. The student must complete the required Solano writing course(s) from where they are initially placed thru English 001. Sentence Skills scores are one of several measures of your eligibility for English composition course(s). It is strongly recommended that all students schedule an appointment with an SCC counselor to determine which course(s) you should take.
