



SCC ASSESSMENT TEST SCORES

Reading Assessment: GE OPTION A DEGREES ONLY! Some degree programs at Solano include a college reading requirement for graduation. *Speak to your counselor to determine whether your degree path includes this requirement.* For these programs, your test scores would result in the following:

READING SCORE	READING COMPREHENSION SCORE RANGES	<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u>
	0—94	Without a score of 95 or higher, students will need to meet the reading requirement with other coursework or test scores. Please consult your counselor if your degree includes this requirement.
	95—120	<u>NONE.</u> With a SCORE OF 95 and ABOVE, your graduation reading requirement for an <u>AA/AS Degree</u> is satisfied.

You may retake the Reading Comprehension test as many times as desired. If you are unsatisfied with your results, there is a one week waiting period before you can re-test.

Sentence Skills Assessment: The Sentence Skills Assessment is NOT a placement test, but is one of several measures used to determine your eligibility for English composition course(s). The following placements are recommendations based on test scores only. Schedule an appointment with a SCC counselor after your assessment to determine final course placement.

	90—120 OR High School GPA 2.7 OR a “B” in Junior or Senior English class OR a C+ in an AP English class	A. <u>ENGLISH 001:</u> College Composition <u>AND</u> <u>LR 10:</u> Lab (1.0 unit) ENGL001 & LR010 applies to AA/AS and 4-year College or University

You may take the Sentence Skills test twice in three years* if you are unsatisfied with your course placement recommendation. There is a one-week waiting period before you can re-test. (If K-12 rule does not apply)

*Once students have attempted a Solano writing course and it shows on their record, they **may not** re-test in Sentence Skills for a new placement. Students must complete the required Solano writing course(s) starting from the last class they attempted (through English 001).

SCC MATH ASSESSMENT

The Math Assessment Test is NOT a placement test, but is one of several measures used to determine students' eligibility for math courses. All students planning to take a math course should first meet with a Solano College Counselor to determine course placement. Bring a high school transcript to your counseling session so that a counselor can discuss all available options with you.*

To waive prerequisites if you meet or exceed the requirements as the result of job/life experience, submit a Substitution/Waiver Petition to Admissions and Records. Find the petition form at <http://www.solano.edu/ar/forms.php>.
