Facilities Master Plan Update

Superintendent-President, Dr. Celia Esposito-Noy, shared the proposed timeline for completing the Facilities Master Plan, and proposed 2019-2020 campus improvement projects for the Fairfield campus: (Additional items for the list should be forwarded to the Superintendent-President's office by Monday evening, October 28, 2019.)

- Improved signage and lighting around campus interior
- Parking Lot 1 repairs
- Purchase of Generator for Substation One
- Heating and cooling system repairs in Building 300
- Installation of digital entry signs at both main entrances to the College
- Installation of interior signs and electronic GPS maps for various buildings to help identify instructional offices
- Power washing and painting of exteriors of old buildings; painting of interior building corridors
- Work with ASSC to identify outside gathering spaces and Building 1400 improvements
- Upgrading electrical wiring in Cosmetology lab
- Install benches in all buildings
- Improve lighting in different buildings (need to include classrooms—dimmer capability and turning off sections)
- Interior paint touchups at Vacaville Center
- Provide solar umbrellas for plugins
- Install computer monitors in all buildings
- Install walk-off mats in all buildings
- Install additional whiteboards in classrooms
- Provide charging stations on campus

- Based on faculty input, designed meta-majors: Pathways for Academic and Career Excellence (PACE).
 - o Linked meta-majors to Holland Types/career resources.
 - Published in the 2019-2020 catalog.
 - o Alignment with Counseling/Student Inquiry Groups
- Fall and Spring Flex Events, including Rob Johnstone and Student Panels.
- On-going professional development, including School visits, flex events, open office hours (as needed).
- Identified GE patterns in collaboration with FYE program (FT3). Designed to pivot on tracks in mathematics (Math 011, 012, 020).
- Crosswalk Guided Pathways planning with Equity Plan and Strategic Plan.
- Began re-design of online student portal.
- High School Counselor Outreach
