SUMMARY:

The final Measure G Bond Spending Plan (BSP) was presented to the Board on April 1, 2015 as an information item. The BSP was reconciled to the latest audited financial report (FY 2013-14) and includes two line items to capture unallocated funds, one for minor capital improvement projects and one for program reserve.

Measure G will be fully closed-out after the following actions occur:

- 1. Staff will prepare a specific list of projects funded by "minor capital improvement projects" and "program reserve" which the Board will be asked to approve in the coming months.
- 2. Staff will create and distribute a "Measure G Report to the Community" before June 30, 2015.
- 3. The District's auditors will prepare a final Measure G audit for FY 2014-15. The audit will be presented to the Board not later than March 31, 2016.

The Board is asked to approve the attached "Measure G Bond Spending Plan."
