CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (CBOC) 2019 MEMBER ROSTER

Section 5. Membership.

(a) Number. The CBOC shall consist of a minimum of nine (9) members appointed by the Board of Trustees from a list of candidates submitting written applications. Every effort will be made to maintain broad geographic representation of the District, and the CBOC composition shall be based on criteria established by Education Code Section 15282, to wit:

• One (1) student enrolled and active in a community college support group, such as student government. The community college student may, at the discretion of the District, serve up to six months after his or her graduation. (A)

• One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District. (B)

- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization. (C)
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers association. (D)
- One (1) member active in a support organization for the college. (E)

• Two (2) at-large members of the community, who are persons who demonstrate interest in and/or experience with the mission and facilities of the District; such as citizen members of occupational advisory groups, local business representatives, or representatives of local civic organizations. (F)

• Two (2) members of the community who demonstrate interest in and/or experience in the construction and building trades. (G)
