## Geology Part of NSF Grant

The SCC Geology Department has been included in a one million dollar, 5-year grant from the National Science Foundation, beginning in 2019.



The five-year grant will help foster and recruit geology majors through 'first experience' Geology field trips.

Solano, along with seven other community colleges, will be part of a series of joint UC Davis – Community College geology field trips.

This grant recruits low-income students to geology by field experience, and then systematically supports them with 50 undergraduate and 21 graduate scholarships leading to graduation.

The million dollar, 5-year NSF grant starts in 2019.
