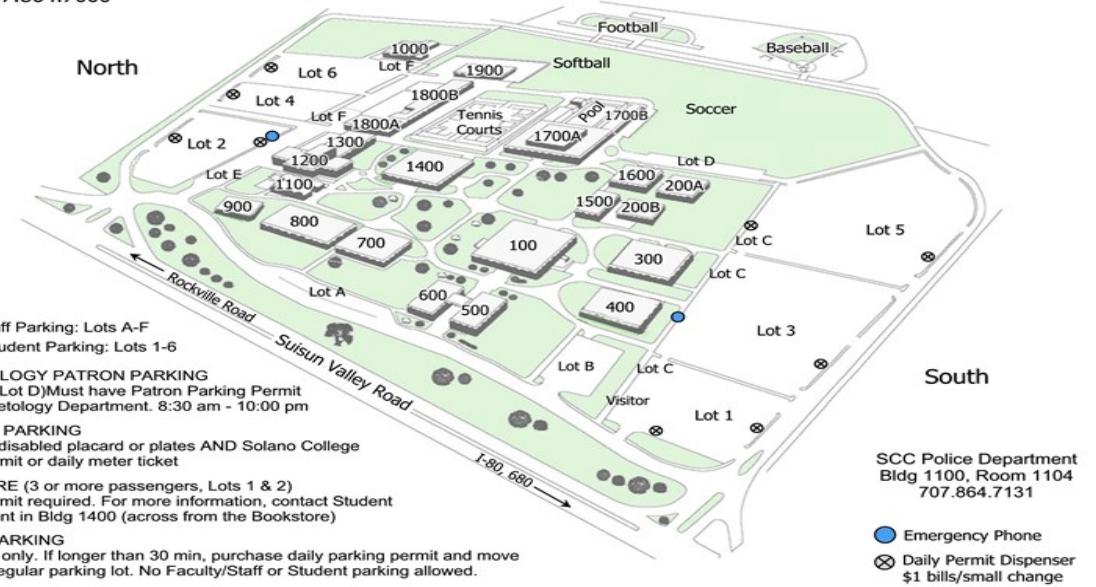

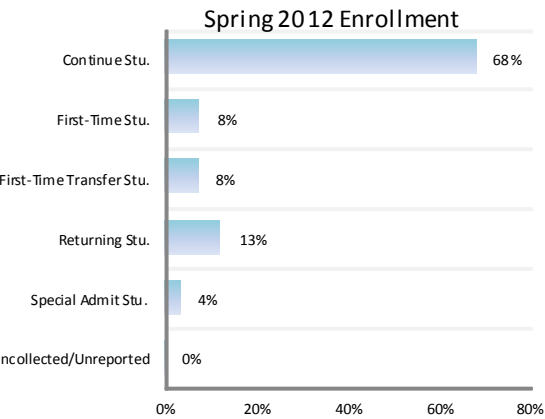

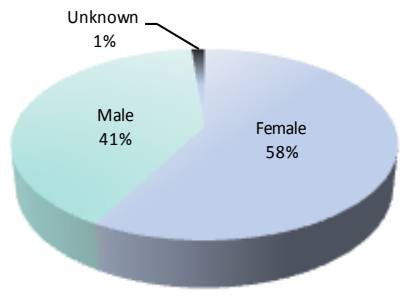

### Transfer Education Planning to UC & CSU

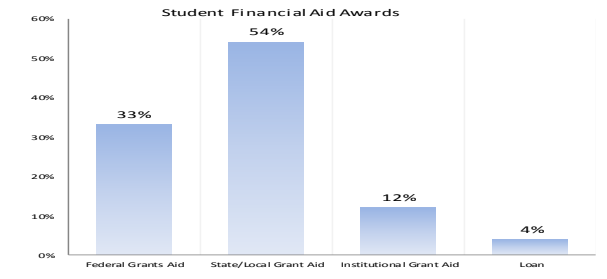
