SCC ADN Policy - Test of Essential Academic Skills - TEAS

- Solano Community College (SCC) Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) Program will accept the New ATI TEAS 7 or previous version with a 62.0% or better score for the 2025 ADN Application period of September 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025. Beginning January 2026 only the New ATI TEAS 7 will be accepted.
- 2. Applicants must create an account at https://www.atitesting.com. The name on the account must match a valid government-issued photo I.D. that must be presented at the time of testing.
- 3. Before testing, it is strongly recommended that you prepare for the ATI TEAS by obtaining official ATI TEAS study materials (study guides, practice exams, etc.) from the ATI website.
- 4. You may take the exam at any approved ATI testing location. Check the ATI website for available dates and locations. SCC no longer provides ATI TEAS testing.
- 5. Transcripts may be ordered directly through the ATI website. SCC will only accept official transcript results received directly from ATI. The name on the transcript must match the name on the record with the SCC data.
- If you do not achieve a minimum passing score of 62.0% on your first TEAS exam, you are strongly encouraged to study with the online TEAS Focused Review and complete additional coursework as needed.
- 7. You can access your ATI TEAS Score Report at any time through your ATI Account under "My Results". In that area, you can create a Focused Review, an online tool that aligns missed question topics and the relevant study materials recommended for review.
- 8. Applicants are allowed a maximum of three attempts per year at achieving a passing adjusted individual score of 62.0%. There must be a minimum of 30 days between retakes.
