

Report on the Student Portion of the CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) as of 7/24/2020

- Solano Community College District has signed and returned the certification and agreement form for HEERF funds. The
 District has used the funds to provide the mandated amount of at least 50% of the emergency financial aid grants to
 students.
- The total amount of funds that the institution has received under the HEERF for student portion is \$1,565,107
- As of July 24, 2020, \$1,577,685 has been distributed to students either by direct deposit or by check
- 7,874 Solano students were deemed eligible for emergency aid
- All 7,874 Solano students were given emergency aid
- The amount of aid to each student was as follows:
 - Students receiving a Pell grant and completing 0.5 to 6 units: \$230
 - Students receiving a Pell grant and completing more than 6 units: \$460
 - Students not receiving a Pell grant and completing 0.5 to 6 units: \$115
 - Students not receiving a Pell grant and completing more than 6 units: \$230
- Students have been notified by text message and the District website that these funds are intended to be used for
 expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, course materials,
 technology, health care, and child-care expenses
