3. AB19 Request for Funds Process Proposal – <i>Patrick Scott was not able to attend. Will bring back at a future meeting</i>
4. Categorical Funds Update <i>Susan presented a summary of the categorical funds and asked which funds the committee wanted more detailed information. It was agreed to bring back details of any accounts that had an aging of more than 2 years and any fund that had over \$900k available. It was also requested to separate out the F/T employees being paid from categorical funds between F/T salaries and Form 6 assignments. A question regarding the ASC (DSPS) and the reason for being understaffed was raised and the committee would like an update. It was suggested that the categorical fund information be brought to College Governance.</i>
