

Dr. Mac Powel, president of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, came to observed and gather input on the quality of student life and education at Solano Community College.

The purpose of accreditation is to strengthen the quality of colleges, which he and other team members across the state will gather in September to discuss areas of improvement and report to the Commission/congress. Dr Powel has over 100 institutions to visit and represents 3 million students.

- Accreditation is what makes allows SCC students to be eligible for Financial Aid.
- Accreditation is a federal process that enables general funds for education (such as grants, laons, and an actual facility).
- Ultimate goal of accreditation is equity.

Senators Wong and Srinivasan, Legislative Advocate Brown, and VP Solis largley led the student feedback discussion.
