Officer Roberts:

- Mentioned a new program coming to Solano that fixes headlights or light bulbs on cars that have been in an accident for free.
- Must be a currently enrolled SCC student and if the accident happened on campus, students will receive a voucher to have the car fixed
- The voucher will include all the steps needed to fix your vehicle
- Drivers will contact the DPS office, listed on the voucher, and can make requests for procedures that cost under \$250. Solano Community College will pay for the replacement bulbs and the other shops. This program will only cover the costs of replacing the car's damaged bulbs.

G. Vallejo Campus Concerns

- a. Update: The idea was proposed to have a new Senator position that can represent the Vallejo and Vacaville campus.
- b. The logistics of creating this new position can be discussed in future meetings, and can be an endeavor that the ASSC pursues if it is deemed necessary
- c. Academic Senate is doing one meeting a semester at the other campus, so presenting ideas for what might and might not work will be important for discussing the future actions of the ASSC.
- d. During the Academic Senate, there was a problem that the students were being forced to get to school by public transport. They were considering making a shuttle system for Solano students; however, right now it would be a good idea to work with the systems in place to expand what transit lines should be expanded upon.
- e. Currently there should be options for students to make transit between campuses. The current public transit system that is being covered only qualifies for certain kinds of programs/lines. This could be an issue of access but could also be an issue of reappropriating assets.

H. Olympics Day Event

- a. The idea is being presented by a singular committee established for this event. (departments involved include Athletics, Nursing, Facilities, Administration)
- b. The committee has not provided a cost estimate breakdown for the event.
- c. The ASSC needs to discuss our level of involvement, whether it includes the ASSC participating in the event or helping sponsor events.
- d. Concerns about the number of events taking place in May, the ASSC budget, and our need to plan the Met Gala event. Another concern about the event celebrating the Olympics is the environmental impact, the fact that the actual event is damaging coral reefs in Tahiti.
- e. Regarding participation, the ASSC will tentatively be helping to co-sponsor the event once we receive some documents (itinerary, cost estimate breakdown, etc.), and possibly have limited physical engagement with the event. Additionally, ways the ASSC could support the event is by donating some games we have in storage.
- f. ASSC members are encouraged to attend these committee meetings if they are interested in being a part of this, whether it is through the ASSC or separately.
- g. Discussion will continue in the next meeting.

I. Met Gala Event

- a. Activities committee decided to cancel the March event coming up, so the alternative that was developed was the Met Gala event
- b. Found that there would be much more engagement with this event
- c. The activities committee created a cost estimate breakdown, the general Canva presentation, and floor layout completed.
- d. Details on what would be offered, and the overall theming, were nailed down in the Activities meeting.
- e. The ASSC plans to reach out to different departments and individuals that could be involved with the event. (clubs, theater department, art department, etc.)
- f. The proposed location was the library, and the proposed date would be a Friday. (potentially from 6-9PM)
- g. The focus of this event is to reach out to the far reaches of the student body on Solano to celebrate and invite all forms of engagement (Speech and Debate, Theater, Art, Faculty/Staff celebration)
- h. More discussions will take place through the Activities committee on the Discord.
- i. Ideas proposed in the meeting were: Working with the drama department for props, opening award nominations to the student body, and including an entrance fee.
