## A. Dr. Shirley Lewis

- a. Faculty and staff are working on a Hispanic Month event with a pinata making contest, Loteria, etc.
- b. Working to modernize the 1400 building such as by putting in a new bigger screen; there will be a 150-inch diagonal screen in the back of the cafeteria; the stage will be removed (which wasn't ADA compliant).

- d. Started a campaign to make people aware of the missing and murdered Indigenous women as most cases of these women missing or murdered are not being solved.

- E. Discussion of college night, in which faculty from other fields will come in to keep the library open late on certain days around finals.
- F. ASTC is making an effort to have widespread tutoring on all campuses and is requesting certain needs that aren't currently being filled.
- G. Legislative Advocate Brown replied that some hours aren't available to everyone, and this opened the discussion for different ways to get student feedback on these hours.
- H. Discussion on adding subjects of the library and ASTC to the Student Life Survey; the ASTC and library would like to collaborate on the Student Life Survery.
- I. Speech and Debate team represented QR codes for the survey, or suggested people going in-person for inquiries.
- J. President Solis suggests asking professors to help with getting feedback.
