SOLANO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

CIVIC CENTER/ USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

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POLICY: There are District facilities which are available for use by community and non-profit groups and for private use. Procedures and rental rates for the use of facilities shall be established by the Superintendent-President or designee and made available on the District's website. Organizations or individuals requesting use of campus facilities shall complete the documentation required by Campus Reservations.

The administrative procedures shall reflect the requirements of applicable law regarding Civic Centers including reasonable rules regarding time, place, and manner of use of District facilities. Public use of District property shall not interfere with scheduled instructional programs or other college activities.

The management, direction, and control of the civic center is vested in the governing board of the community college district. The governing board of the community college district shall make all needful rules and regulations for conducting the civic meetings and for such recreational activities as are provided for in this chapter and which aid, assist, and lend encouragement to the activities.

No group or organization may use District property for purposes that discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, disability, sex, gender, sexual orientation, or the perception that a person has one or more of the foregoing characteristics.
