Accessibility Services Center Testing Procedures:

- 1. Accommodation letters and routing slips should be submitted to your instructors at the beginning of the semester. Please remind your instructor at least 5-7 days prior to your testing date so the professor can submit the exam and routing slip.
- 2. Students can contact the Accessibility Services Center Testing Center to schedule their exam through ASCTesting@solano.edu, or by calling 707-864-7118. Be sure to include your full name, Solano ID number, and phone number with any communication to the ASC Testing Center, or in-person Monday-Thursday between 8:30AM-3PM. Building 400, Room 442. There are NO DROP- IN appointments for testing.
- 3. Students are required to bring their own scantrons.
- 4. A valid Solano ID is required for all testing and must be shown at the time of check-in.
- 5. A Routing Slip must accompany every exam or quiz.
- 6. The ASC Testing Center does not allow the use of laptops, cell phones, headphones, smart watches, electronic dictionaries or other electronic devices, hats/hoods. **No exceptions.**
- 7. ASC students are responsible for submitting their current ASC Application before visiting the ASC Testing Center.
- 8. It is the student's responsibility to discuss their accommodation with their instructor prior to the exam. <u>If permitted resources are not indicated on the routing slip, they will not be allowed.</u>
- 9. <u>If you are unable to maintain your scheduled testing day and time, it is **YOUR** responsibility to contact your instructor and the ASC Testing Center to discuss rescheduling the exam.</u>
- 10. Please arrive 10-15 minutes prior to your exam to allow time for check-in. Otherwise, you may need to reschedule your exam.
- 11. No specific rooms or seating are reserved for any student. All exams and quizzes will be proctored on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 12. Please note that you may be recorded or monitored through cameras during your proctored tests.
- 13. Restroom Breaks are allowed during the test time but if your accommodations do not indicate you receive a break, time will not be added to the end of your test.

Academic Integrity: Any student found engaging with academic dishonesty will be reported to the <u>instructor</u>. The student's exam will be *stopped immediately*, and the student will then have their testing services reviewed by the Accessibility Services Center Coordinator.
