To earn the Associate in _____ in _____ for Transfer, students must:

1. Complete 60 semester units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including both of the following:
 - a. The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC)
 - b. A minimum of 18 semester units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by Solano Community College District
2. Obtain a minimum grade point average of 2.0
3. Complete all courses within the major with a minimum grade of C or P if taken on a Pass/No Pass basis
