# SCC Fix-A-Falcon Bulb Replacement Program


- Program will replace traffic citations with repair vouchers for broken bulbs on vehicles.


#### **Spiraling Affects Explained**

- 1. Starts with fixing traffic citation.
- 2. Student spends money and time to get bulb repaired.
- 3. Repair shop cost can run up to \$250 or more.
- 4. Student needs to find an officer to sign off fixing ticket.
- 5. Will need to pay fines and fees.
- 6. If fees/fines aren't paid on time they will be sent to collection.
- 7. Collections will lower credit score. Purchasing/borrow powering goes down.


