

Guided Pathways Meeting Notes Friday, February 24, 2023



Although the group hasn't met for a number of weeks, there have been numerous meetings with related groups. Melissa has also been meeting with sub-teams regarding our original plan. Other Meetings & Suggestions:

Kristin and Melissa had meeting with Jesus & Alfredo regarding the May event regarding when and timing of the event. Jesus and Alfredo put out feelers to the schools and it didn't seem like they were very enthusiastic about it. The other thing that emerged is that the Student Equity Plan was a Summer Bridge and Welcome Day. Perhaps we need to put our energies there.

Kelvin recommended partnering with the Maker's Faire to invite folks in the community to create cool items and gadgets. So, we're not really sure if its an audience that we are targeting. Is there an audience we want to reach? Are there going to be other programs that are tabling and we don't have a "fun" project to do? Karen has put out a if other CTE programs being there and it is going to be lots of stuff going on.

Deb says maybe a mistake we're making is that we need to remember they are all potential students.

Maker's Faire – April 22nd is a possibility. Is Outreach going to be there? Jesus believes it's the first time that he's heard of the event.

Jesus currently has scheduled college faires on the calendar for a couple of high school locked in with students at Buckingham, Dixon High School etc. Need to follow up on the dates and times. This is something that has been coming up in the Equity Plan that has been coming up as well. That faculty comes out to high school events. This was something that was done through ESL programs & there were local trade schools. Solano Autotech was out there by himself and he was alone. Historically, there hasn't been a partnership with Outreach and Solano. Often, a lot of the faculty don't even know these things are happening and perhaps if some of the faculty are teaching online, perhaps they would have more flexibility.

There is an intrinsic desire to attend Summer Bridge and Welcome Day – since students are often nervous.

- Equity Plan goal of Summer Bridge Program to create a welcoming environment for African American Students. They were talking about all the different summer program we'd like to share with students. But the idea is for students to build community prior to classes starting not just information dump.
 - o Multi-Day
- > We also need a general event WELCOME DAY
 - August 7-8 Community Building
 - August 9 Full scale welcome

 - Melissa is feeling a bit unsure about how to approach it b/c there are no managers attached to it and there are pieces she's unaware of and not knowledgeable about.
 - So much of this is addressed in the Equity Plan we need to be informing everyone and in agreement.
