During the process of construction and RFI/Submittal review, the following changes needed to made:

• COR 8: Due to lead time concerns, a substitute valve was ordered to meet the project sched It was later determined the ordered valves were not specified for heating hot water systems to the high temperatures. These valves need to be replaced with specific valves rated heating hot water systems. The valves that are being replaced will be salvaged to be a during the next hydronic improvement project on the chilled water system.

Matrix HG, Inc.'s Change Order #2 request includes an extension of the contract duration to Noven 19, 2025.
