#### **SUMMARY:**

#### CONTINUED FROM THE PREVIOUS PAGE

During the process of construction and RFI/submittal review, the following changes needed to be made:

- COR 6: Due to noise requirements of the District-hosted Tennis Tournament, the District asked the Contractor to relocate their staging area. The Contractor also had to relocate their conex (storage container) box, all materials and fabrication set up to an alternate location on campus. There were also additional relocations associated with the Sand Volleyball Court Project as well as the underground gas leak investigation and repair. Each move included labor as well as cost for an outside company to move the conex.
- COR 7: Upon excavation of the underground piping running from the Building 300 vault to the Building 300 mechanical room, it was discovered that the existing concrete footing was not sufficient to provide a safe and structurally sound installation of the new underground piping in this area. The Consultant provided a framework for improving the structural integrity of the footing. The Contractor performed work that included doweling, formwork, rebar, and new concrete.

Following is a summary of the contract and impact of Change Order #4 if approved:
