

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT BIDDING

## BUILDING 1800B ELECTRIAL UPGRADES PROJECT (PROJECT #25-025)

- Q. Where can I find information about Project No. 25-025?
- A. Contract Documents can be viewed or downloaded on the Solano Community College District's website: https://www.solano.edu/measureq/bidding-opportunities.php
- Q. What is the scope for this project?
- A. The project will add transformers and panels, as well as re-distribute electrical loads in the classrooms of this building. Additive Alternate Bid #1 will replace the original electrical panels throughout the building. Additive Alternate Bid #2 replace will the existing luminaires in kind. The existing mounting and circuiting and switch legs for the luminaires are to be re-used.
- Q. What is the anticipated start and duration for this project?
- A. The anticipated construction schedule is March 20th, 2026 April 16th, 2026
- Q. Will there be a MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE for this project?
- A. There will be a Mandatory Virtual Pre-Bid Conference (web-based meeting via Microsoft Teams) Friday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 11:00 am. All interested parties must send a request to participate to tony.velasco@solano.edu. An optional site-visit will be conducted during the procurement period. The District will hold the job walk Monday, December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, 11:00 am 11:30 am.
- Q. Is this project subject to a Project Labor Agreement (PLA)?
- A. No.
- Q. Does the General Contractor have to be pre-qualified with your District in order to bid this project?
- A. No.
- Q: Is there an Engineer's Estimate for the project?
- A: This project was registered with the Division of State Architect with a project estimate of \$250,000.
- Q: Is the non-mandatory job walk required to be attended?
- A: Contractors do not have to attend the District job walk (December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025), however, bidders must conduct, and independent site walk and certify this was completed during the procurement phase. Refer to specification 00 45 01.
- Q: For SLDBE participation, If the prime contractor is already a small business will that contribute towards the 20% participation goal? Does DVBE participation contribute towards the overall goal?

A: Per specification 00 45 20 (SLDBE), "The participation of a general contractor that meets the criteria for SLDBE shall be counted towards the 20% goal." DVBE participation also is an approved business category for credit towards the project goal.
