- The mission of the Puente Project is to increase the number of underrepresented students who enroll in four-year colleges and universities, earn degrees and return to the community as leaders and mentors to future generations.
- Puente students succeed and transfer at twice the rate of controls, with retention averages 92% statewide for Puente students.
- Puente is open to all students.
